



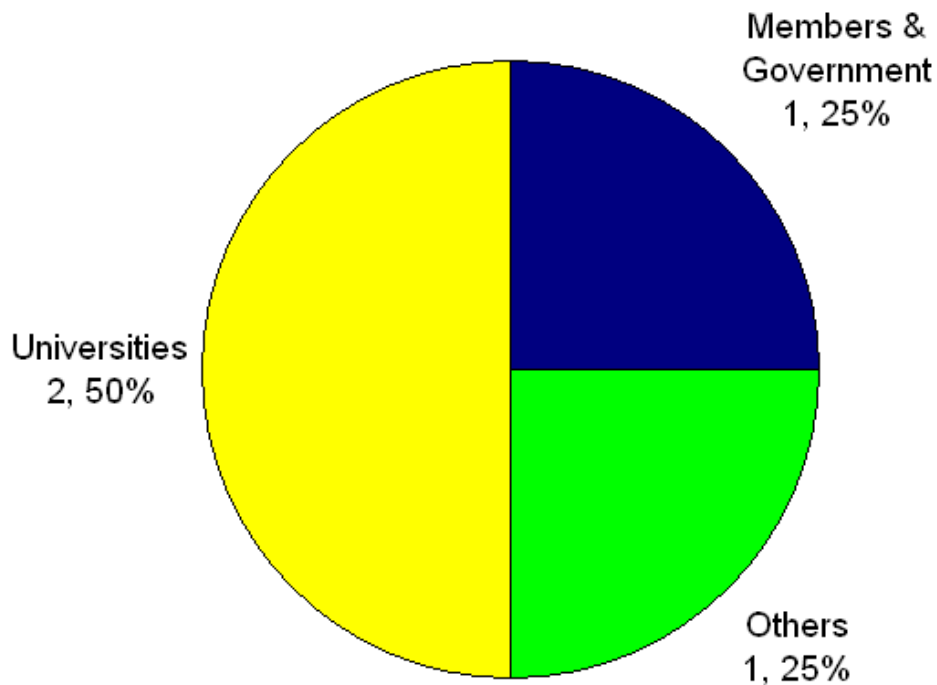

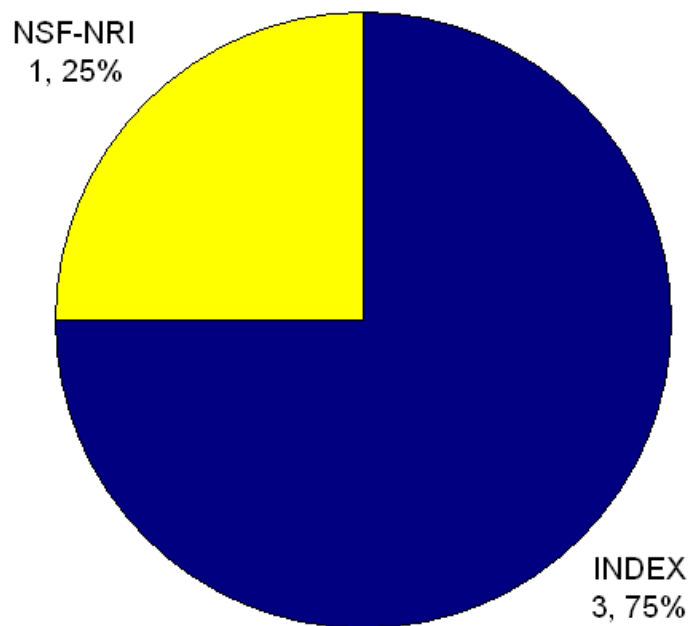
2007 NRI Student Metrics

Completed end of 1Q08

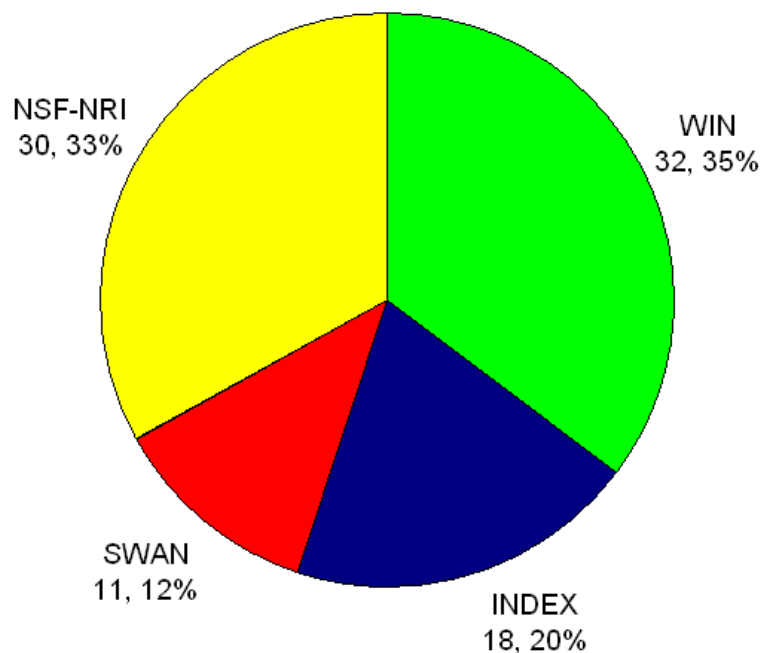
NRI graduated its first students in 2007. Of the four that graduated, 1 joined a member company, 2 went to universities, and one joined a non-member company.

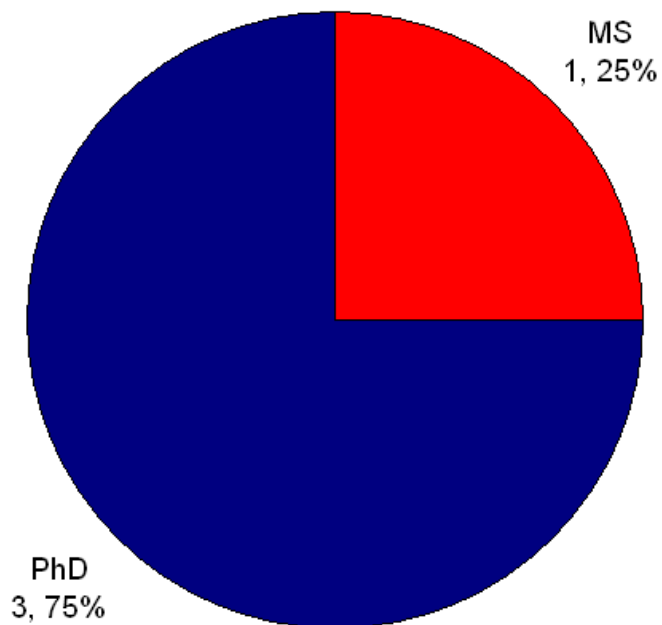

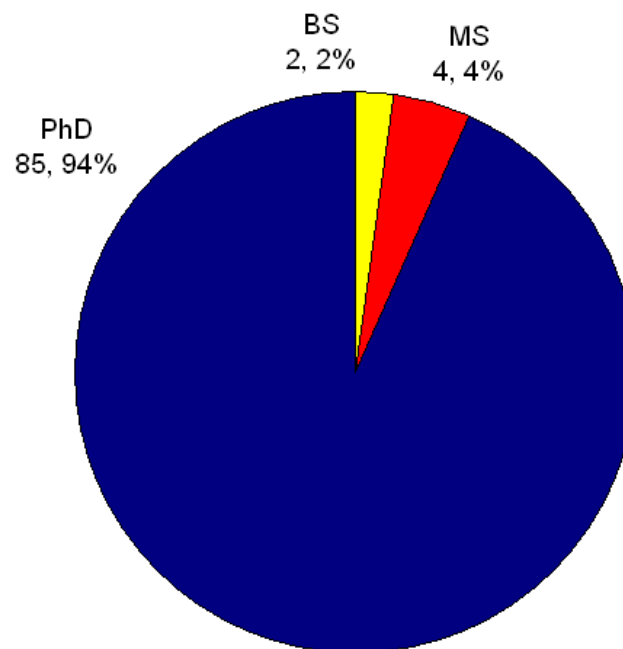


Of the 4 NRI 2007 graduates, 3 were in the INDEX Center, one in the NSF/NRI Center. Two-thirds of the current students are divided between the WIN and NSF/NRI Centers; the remaining third is split between the INDEX and SWAN Centers.

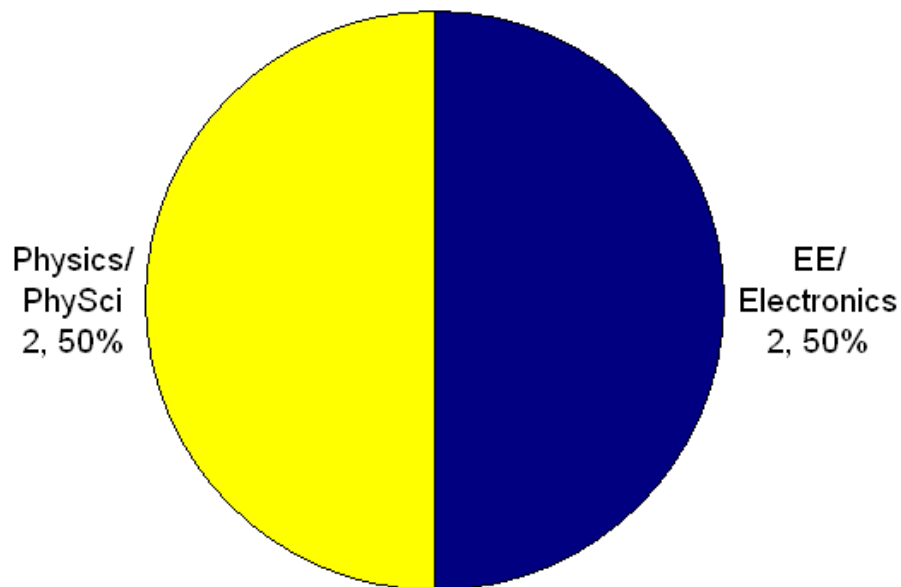

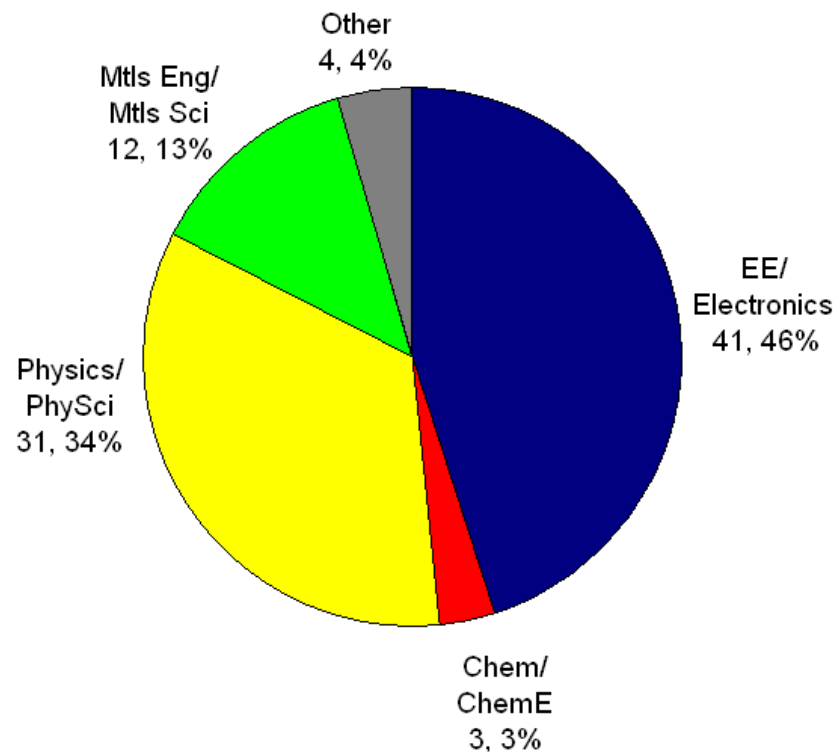

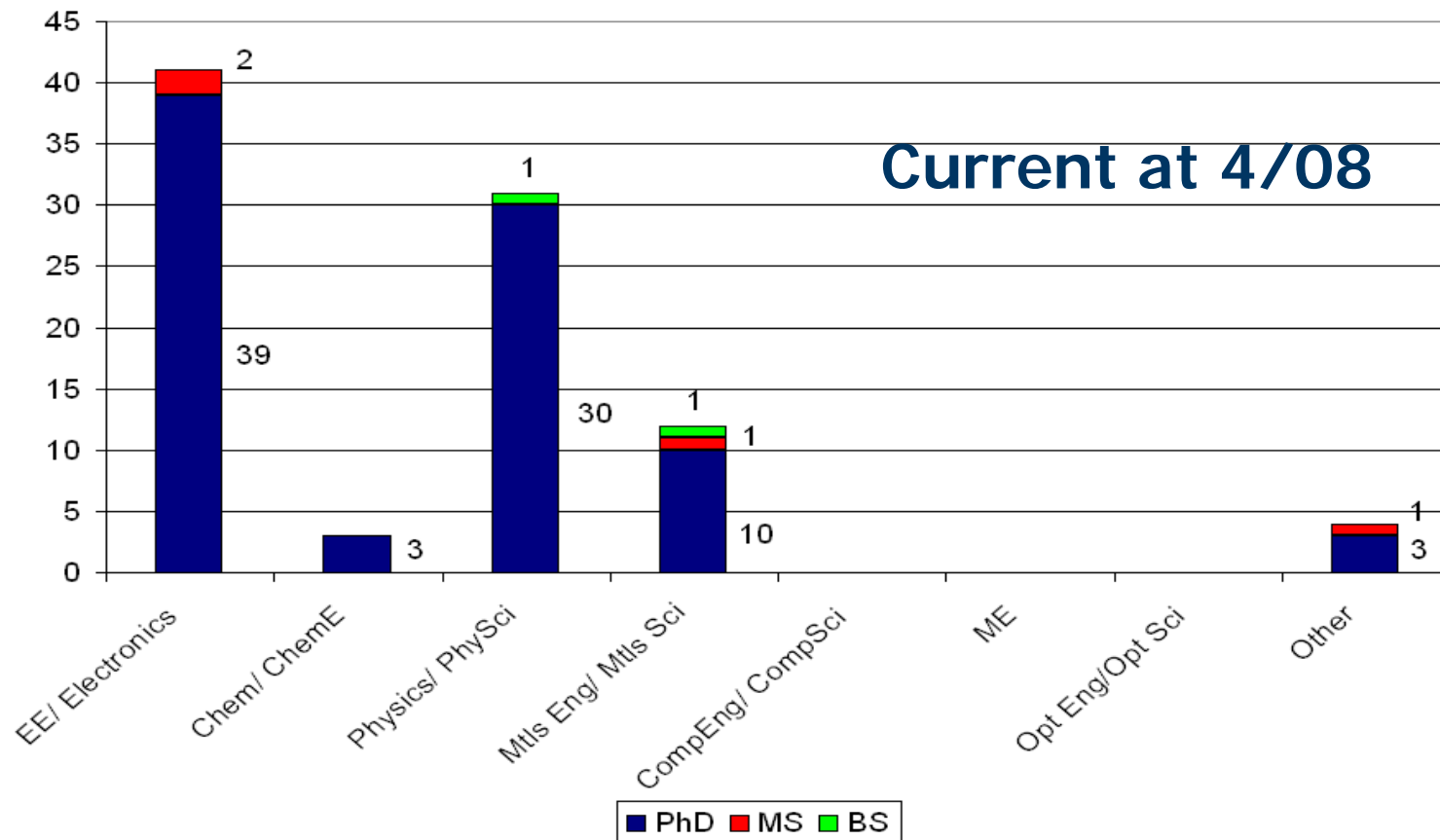
Current Students



The 2007 NRI graduates were evenly divided between Physics/Physical Sciences and EEs. The current population is more heavily weighted toward EEs.

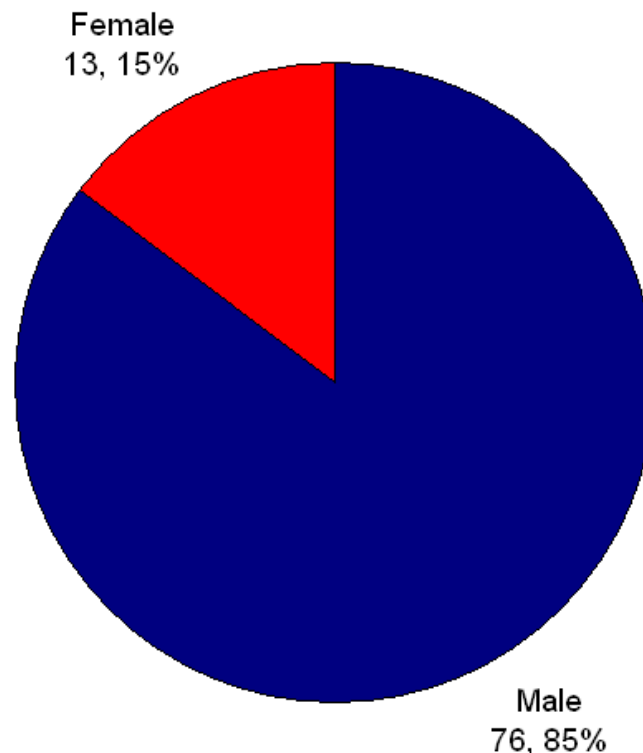
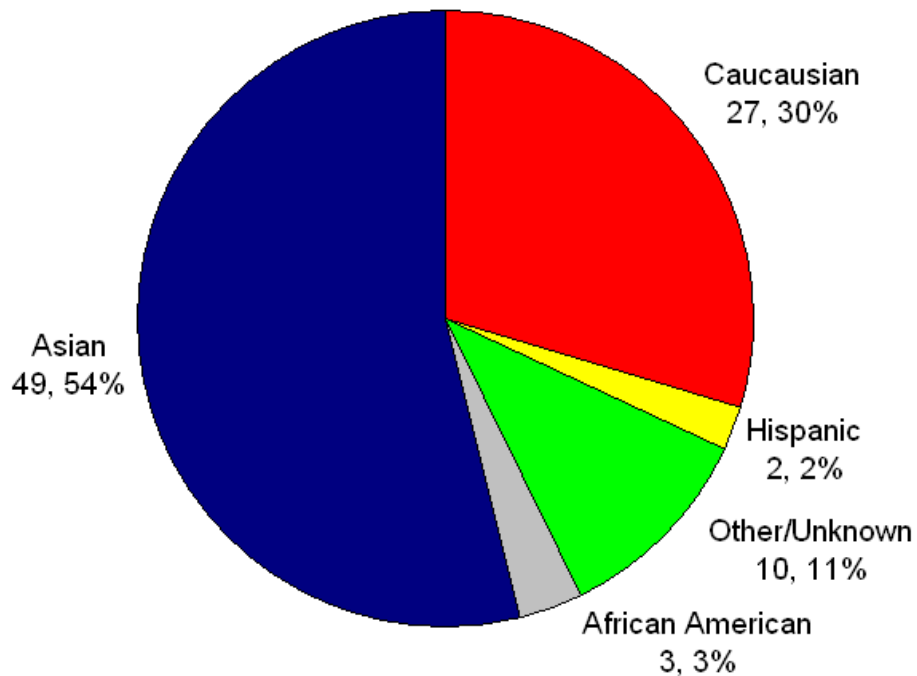


2007 Metrics: Students by Degree and Discipline



The 2007 Graduates were 2 PhDs in EE and 1 PhD and 1 MS in Physics/Physical Sciences. The current population is primarily PhD across disciplines with the notable exception of no students in Computer Engineering/ Computer Science.

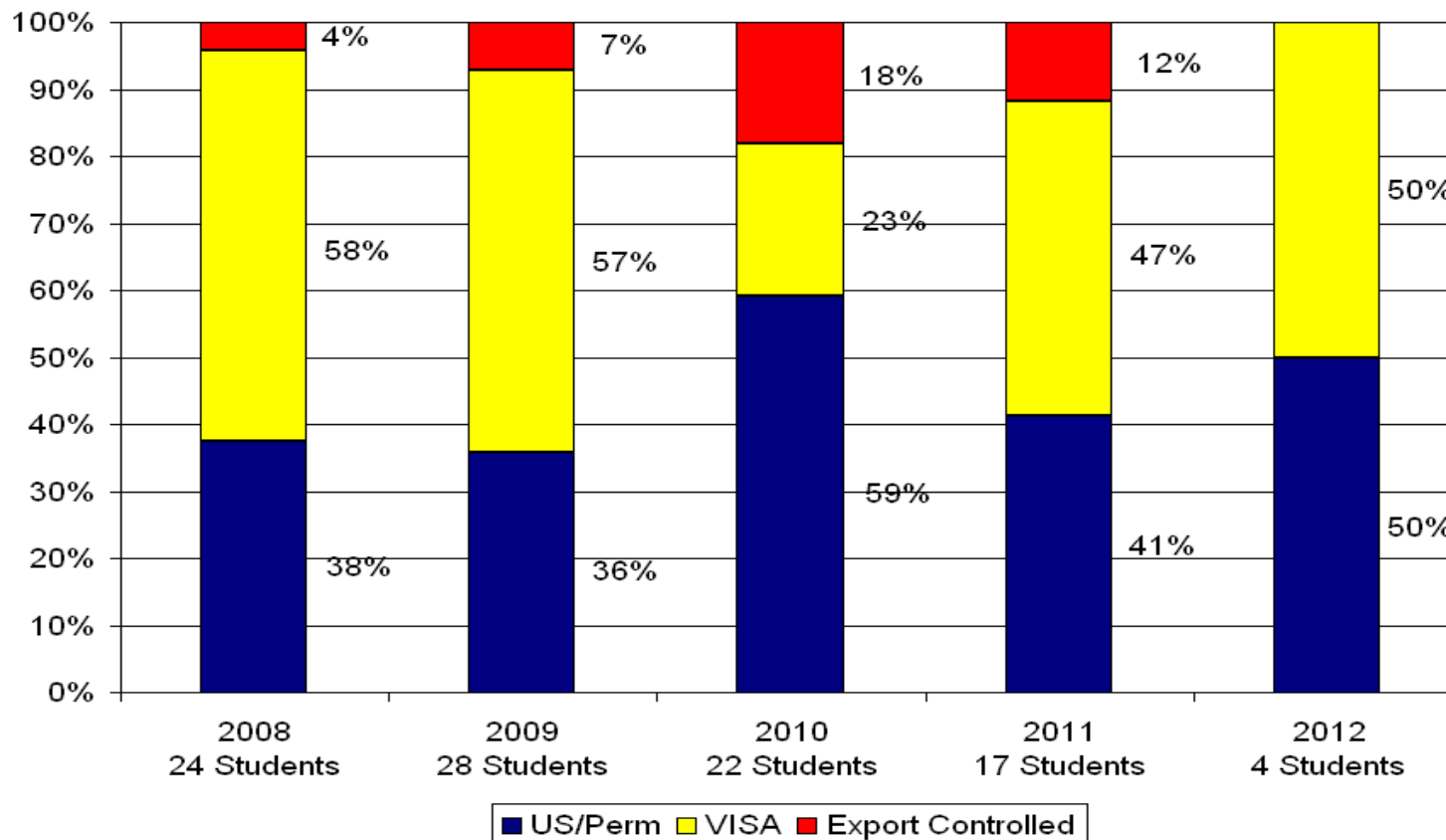
Current at 4/08

This chart is students current at 4/08 divided by expected grad date over the next five years and right-to-work status. The 2007 NRI graduates were 25% PRTW, 50% Visa, and 25% Export Controlled.
